ENTRIES

- *** RUN FEE: For riders who are not BE members**
- **ALL RIDERS & HORSES MUST BE REGISTERED WITH BRITISH EVENTING BEFORE MAKING AN ENTRY (THIS IS FREE AND CAN BE DONE VIA THE BE WEBSITE if you are not already a BE member)**
- All entries should be made online once approved by your Branch DC/Centre Proprietor using www.britisheventing.com; Fixtures; Blindley Heath (1). This is a single booking form process and entries will not be confirmed without payment.
- **In SPECIALS REQUEST BOX: Please state your BRANCH, TEAM / INDIVIDUAL and any other special requests.**
- **Entry Queries** should be raised with your DC/Centre Proprietor; then the Entries Secretary

For Pony Club entries you will need your **membership number** and Branch/Centre to enter a qualifying class.

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee as stated online.

After the closing date substitutions may only be made as per P.C. Eventing Rules 2024.

Any changes after the closing date need to go through the DC who will advise the Entry Secretary by email: dmillerhds@gmail.com. For **ALL** changes of horse

and rider substitutions after the closing date (7th May) there is a £12 charge. A change of horse and rider would constitute a new entry. Details of how to pay will be advised.

Withdrawals and refunds

If a Branch or Centre withdraws a team or an individual **prior to the closing date for entries** to the competition, a full refund will be given, less an administration charge.

Withdrawals after the closing date for entries will NOT be refunded except on the production of a vet's or doctor's certificate.

In the event of abandonment entries will be refunded as per BE Rules.

Rosettes and prize giving

Rosettes for individuals: 1st – 8th

Rosettes for teams: 1st – 6th

Craddock rosettes will be awarded to all competitors in the PC100 and Chairman's Cup who achieve clear rounds in both the show jumping and cross country without time penalties.

All results will be available on [PonyClubResults](#) on the day.

Prize giving will be in the marquee and prize winners must be correctly dressed.

Entry Conditions

- To be run in accordance with **BE Rules and Pony Club Rules**.
- **Dress and tack:** as per the Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2024
- Competitors must ensure their **numbers** are downloaded and **printed (not handwritten)** from the link on [eventingscores.co.uk](#) when times are published. Two numbers, front and back, must be worn at all times whilst mounted.
- Competitors must bring their own number bib.

- **Horses and ponies must NOT be left tied up outside their horsebox unattended. Please do not muck out or leave rubbish on site.**
- **No cars in the Horse Box Park**
- **Owners/Supporters:** if travelling separately please **PRINT RIDER NUMBER & DISPLAY** in the windscreen.
- **No horse** will be allowed to compete in 2 classes.
- **Photographic Rights** – competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
- A valid **passport and vaccination** record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the current Pony Club vaccination rules 2024 – **please refer to the website. Under BE rules competing horses MUST have had a vaccination within 6 calendar months and 21 days of the competition but not have the relevant vaccination on any of the seven days before it is to compete at the event.**
- Any requests for **Reasonable Adjustment** must be made through the Area Rep, Abby Bernard [http://area11@pcuk.org](mailto:area11@pcuk.org) by the closing date of entries.
